Swimming Carnival

The swimming carnival will be held at the **Glennie Aquatic Centre** on **Thursday 16 November**, from **9:00am -12:00pm**.

Students may be dropped off at the Glennie Aquatic Centre between 8:30 and 9:00am.

Please do not drop students off or enter the Aquatic Centre earlier than 8:30am.

All students have been assessed for swimming readiness. If students are able to swim a lap of the pool unassisted, they may compete in that competitive event. Younger students, and less confident swimmers, will participate in a range of fun swimming rotations.

The main benefit, is that younger students who are capable of swimming competitively, can participate in those competitive events. Students younger than the 8-year-old age group (born 2009), will participate in the Prep - Year 2 group together.

Parents may collect their children at the end of the carnival and take them home. A bus will be provided for all other students back to school for the remainder of the day.

Please note, parents may not collect children from other families unless the child's parent has notified the school office or child's teacher in writing or in person.
